We have found that exploring these components and finding ways for a team to raise their performance levels is almost always best achieved using experiential means.

We have access to a range of team activities that can be used either indoors or outdoors – or a combination of the two. Self awareness tools such as MBTI can have their place.



Our favourite outdoor venue is the Beaulieu Development Centre in the heart of the New Forest in Hampshire where the facilities are terrific and safety second to none. The activities provide a balance between mere fun and encouraging people into their 'learning zone' in order to develop effective processes.

The key feature of our work here is to transfer the enjoyment to applied processes back in the work place by:

- Fully Facilitated Review
- A Review session that is integral to the activity
- Learning is explicit and overt
- The process and learning is more important than the achievement of the activity
- Facilitator will introduce models and theory to support the learning where appropriate
- A commitment to 'Back at Work' actions
